



Proclamation

Whereas: The Town of Brookhaven wishes to honor those individuals who have served the residents of our community with passion and commitment. On April 20th, Mark Baisch will be honored at the Rocky Point Lions Club 'A "Lions" Taste of Long Island,' benefiting The Marty Lyons Foundation, The Rocky Point Historical Society and the Rocky Point Lions Club; and

Whereas: After spending his youth in Shoreham Village, after college, Mark founded Patriot Paper in Boston; manufacturing 100% recycled paper from office waste paper. Upon sale of this successful venture, Mark began Landmark Properties, a single family home and senior condominium construction business. Due to Landmark's success, Mark has been able to identify local interests which would most benefit from his expertise. In 2010 Mark, along with Joe Cognitore of Rocky Point VFW, conceived a plan to build homes for returning Iraq and Afghanistan Veterans. Mark/Landmark are involved with the Tesla Science Center and have assisted in numerous Environmental, Studies, Contract & Title issues and the ultimate purchase of this valuable historical property; and

Whereas: In 2013 Mark became passionate about another local issue, the preservation of the circa 1721 Noah Hallock House, as an imminent sale threatened survival of this local treasure. Mark stepped in, loaned the Rocky Point Historical Society the amount needed to purchase the home, and then Mark/Landmark split a ¼ acre from the 1 acre site to allow Landmark to build a house, at cost, to be sold in an effort to extinguish all debt on the Historical Society's cherished property.
